# ADVANCED NOTICE: SCHOOL CENSUS DAY FRIDAY, 13th February, 2015

Friday, 13th February is School Census Day. All children should attend school on that day and absence should only be if it is absolutely necessary.

If your child is absent on Friday 13th February, a note explaining the child's absence must be presented to the school teacher on the child's return on Monday 17th February.

This is of course a requirement that applies to everyday of the school year, however, Census data is directly related to Government funding for our schools and the requirements outlined above are set by the Department of Education.

# CHILD PROTECTION—CEO PARRAMATTA MODULE & THE NEW WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK



The Working with Children Check is a three step process which includes Completion of the CEO Online Child Protection Module and Completion of the 'new working with children check' through the NSW Commission for Children website. Applicants will then need to present the completed documentation at their local Roads & Maritime Service (RMS) Office (formally RTA) for screening which completes the check.

PLEASE NOTE: Partial Completion of the above steps will not be accepted. Completion of only the CEO Module will not allow you to assist in the classroom

1. It is a Diocesan requirement that any parent volunteering at Christ the King School complete the Child Protection training module.

This training is to be completed online at:

CTK will receive email notification when you complete the CEO module.

2. When module has been completed go to: www.kidsguardian.nsw.gov.au and follow the links to complete the 'new working with children check'. A Working With Children Check is a prerequisite for anyone in child-related work. It involves a national criminal history check and review of findings of workplace misconduct.

Only paid workers in child-related work are required to pay the \$80 fee for a five year clearance. This equates to \$16 per year, the lowest in Australia (together with Victoria).

The Working With Children Check remains free for:

- Volunteers and students
- Authorised carers

- Potential adoptive parents
- Adults who reside in the home of:
  - an authorised carer
  - a family day care service provider
- a home-based education and care service provider.
- **3.** Once the RMS check has been completed you will receive an email which will state that you have clearance to work with children. **You will need** to present a copy of the RMS email to the school office to complete your Working with Children Check. **Only then** will you be cleared to work with the children in the school.

#### Community vacancies at RIDBC VisionEd Preschool

RIDBC VisionEd Preschool is a reverse integration preschool catering for children with a vision impairment. This means that we enroll up to 5 children per day who have a vision impairment plus 10 children from the local community. The preschool runs just like any other preschool but we have the advantages of high staff ratios, wonderful resources and a hands-on, dynamic curriculum. We follow the National Quality Standard guidelines and received an overall rating of Exceeding the National Quality Standard in our accreditation. We have a high staff ratio (currently 3 full time plus one part time staff) for 15 children which enables us to build strong relationships with each of the children and their families.

We currently have vacancies for community children for 2015. The preschool operates Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday from 9:00 until 3:00 during school terms catering for children aged 3-5 years. Children can attend 1, 2 or 3 days per week and fees are \$51 per day for 3 year olds and \$48 per day for 4 year olds.
