Ride Bands will be available for purchase by all visitors on the day but not at the reduced rate. On the day, Ride Bands will cost \$30 and single rides will cost \$5.

Please complete the slip below and return to the school office by 4.9.15 in an envelope clearly marked "SPRING FAIR RIDE BANDS" with your cash or cheque (made payable to CTK P&F).

Children will be issued with a numbered receipt on Friday 11th September, the day before the Spring Fair. The eldest child at CTK will also be given the numbered receipts for immediate members of the family who are not students of CTK. On the day of the Spring Fair, you can redeem your Ride Bands by submitting the numbered receipt at the Ride Ticket Booth.
