Last Wednesday Christ the King had 4 students represent their school and Mackillop at the NSW PSSA Carnival at Homebush. These students represented their school with some outstanding efforts.

Junior Boys 4 x 100m relay

Our relay team (Daniel Bertolissio, Marcus Younis, Nathan Hall, & Anthony Younis) delivered a tremendous performance. In their first heat the team came 1st with a time of 58.98 sec. This time qualified them for the semi-finals consisting of 2 heats. The team came second in their heat with a time of 58.42 seconds. This time qualified them for the finals in which the team came 8th overall in the State with a time of 58.41 seconds. The Christ the King community is extremely proud of their performance, particularly on a a very long and hot day. What a great achievement!

Boys 9yrs 100m dash

Daniel Bertolissio also had the opportunity to run in the 100m heats and semi finals on Wednesday. He then

qualified for the finals on Thursday. Daniel delivered an outstanding result coming 1st in the Finals making him the State Champion for a second year in a row. He ran an amazing time of 13.82 seconds which is also his personal best time. Congratulations to Daniel.

Boys 8yrs 100m dash

Our youngest team member, Marcus Younis, ran in the 100m heats and semi finals on Wednesday. He qualified for the finals on Thursday, achieving an outstanding result of 6th in the State at a time of 15.20 seconds. Congratulations to Marcus.

FETE—CTK CRAFT CLUB



Year 5 are Change Detectives!





CHILD PROTECTION—CEO PARRAMATTA MODULE & THE NEW WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK



The Working with Children Check is now a three step process which includes Completion of the CEO Online Child Protection Module and Completion of the 'new working with children check' through the NSW Commission for Children website. Applicants will then need to present the completed documentation at their local Roads & Maritime Service (RMS) Office (formally RTA) for screening which completes the check.

1. It is a Diocesan requirement that any parent volunteering at Christ the King School complete the Child Protection training module.

This training is to be completed online at:

http://childprotection.parra.catholic.edu.au

CTK will receive email notification when you complete the CEO module. The Child Protection module MUST be completed every 2 years.


2. When module has been completed go to: www.kids.nsw.gov.au and follow the links to complete the 'new working with children check'. A Working With Children Check is a prerequisite for anyone in child-related work. It involves a national criminal history check and review of findings of workplace misconduct.

Only paid workers in child-related work are required to pay the \$80 fee for a five year clearance. This equates to \$16 per year, the lowest in Australia (together with Victoria).

The Working With Children Check remains free for:

- Volunteers and students
- Authorised carers

- Potential adoptive parents
- Adults who reside in the home of:
 - an authorised carer
 - a family day care service provider
- a home-based education and care service provider.
- 3. Once the RMS check has been completed you will receive an email which will state that you have clearance to work with children. A copy of the RMS email will need to be presented to the school office to complete your Working with Children Check. Only then will you be cleared to work with the children in the school.
