#### 2013 Sport Report

Term 4 is coming to a close and sport for 2013 is soon coming to an end as we begin to look towards the 2013- 2014 summer season.

This year has seen a large amount of student participation in a variety of sports.

Students have been involved in lunchtime sport competitions, representative carnivals and diocesan gala days.

Throughout 2013 we have had over 200 students compete and represent Christ the King across a number of sports. Christ the King has entered over 23 teams in over 9 different gala days and competitions throughout the year. These sports have included soccer, touch football, Rugby 7s, cross county, athletics, swimming and netball.

Christ the King has had representative success in the swimming pool, at cross-country and on the athletics track. The school has had over 15 athletes represent Parramatta Diocese in individual pursuit events as well as team sports. Over 5 of these students went on to represent Mackillop in NSW CCC events.

On a classroom curriculum level our children at Christ the King have been involved in athletics, gymnastics, dance and have also had a variety of games and sport lessons with Mrs Lara Kelly-Hosking every week. The NRL backyard development program has worked with our students in developing their skills in touch football as well in term 3.

It is wonderful to see the level of participation in physical education and sporting competitions in which Christ the King students are involved.

On behalf of the staff I would like to take the time to thank our School Principal Mrs Annelise Stockey for her ongoing support of sport at Christ the King. Thank you to the school sport committee for their contributions towards the organisation and resourcing of school sport in 2013. Thank you to the school Colour House Captains for their enthusiasm and dedication. Thank you to the classroom teachers for your support of students participating in these gala days during regular classroom learning time. Lastly, thank you to the parents and community members who have given up their time to manage, car pool, volunteer and help support your child's school in the last three terms in sport.

#### CHILD PROTECTION—CEO PARRAMATTA MODULE & THE NEW WORKING WITH CHILDREN CHECK



The Working with Children Check is now a three step process which includes Completion of the CEO Online Child Protection Module and Completion of the 'new working with children check' through the NSW Commission for Children website. Applicants will then need to present the completed documentation at their local Roads & Maritime Service (RMS) Office (formally RTA) for screening which completes the check.

1. It is a Diocesan requirement that any parent volunteering at Christ the King School complete the Child Protection training module.

This training is to be completed online at:

#### http://childprotection.parra.catholic.edu.au

CTK will receive email notification when you complete the CEO module. The Child Protection module MUST be completed every 2 years.

2. When module has been completed go to: www.kids.nsw.gov.au and follow the links to complete the 'new working with children check'. A Working With Children Check is a prerequisite for anyone in child-related work. It involves a national criminal history check and review of findings of workplace misconduct.

Only paid workers in child-related work are required to pay the \$80 fee for a five year clearance. This equates to \$16 per year, the lowest in Australia (together with Victoria).

The Working With Children Check remains free for:

- Volunteers and students
- Authorised carers

- Potential adoptive parents
- Adults who reside in the home of:
  - an authorised carer
  - a family day care service provider
- a home-based education and care service provider.
- 3. Once the RMS check has been completed you will receive an email which will state that you have clearance to work with children. A copy of the RMS email will need to be presented to the school office to complete your Working with Children Check. Only then will you be cleared to work with the children in the school.


